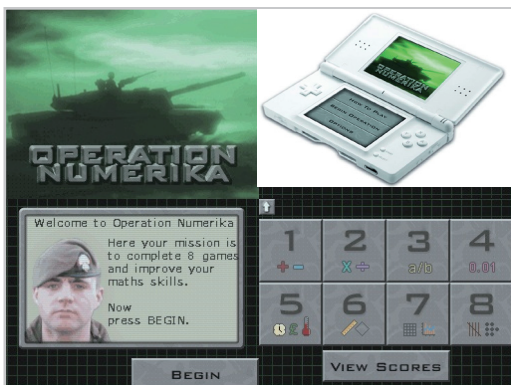

Aimed at recruits into the British Army, many of whom lack the required numeracy skills. A traditional classroom and workbook



approach wasn't working – something new that better suited the needs of developing soldiers was required. The solution is an interactive, gaming solution delivered on Nintendo DS, helping soldiers raise their numeracy levels.

This is the first educational package designed on Nintendo DS, providing context specific support to individual adult learners. You may see kids using Nintendo DS, but did you ever expect to see a soldier playing on one?

Although RAF personnel are well aware of potential security threats, the increasingly sophisticated 'non traditional' threats need to be addressed, particularly among junior officers.



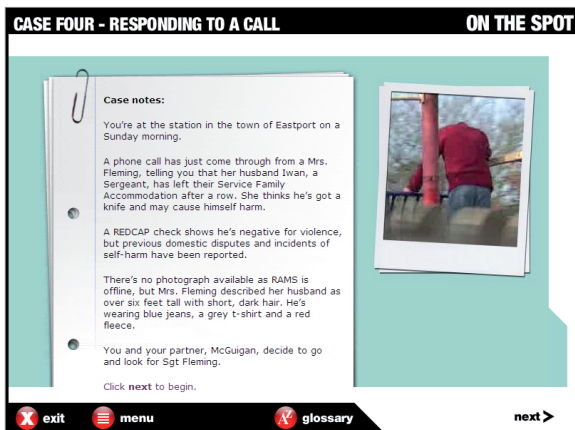

## Royal Military Police 'Stop and Search'

You're on the spot – decide whether to stop, search or detain a suspect ensuring correct protocol whilst keeping the suspect calm. Get it wrong and you'll get a rollicking from the desk sergeant. Get it very wrong and you could start a riot!



Our task was to convert the lengthy and somewhat dry material on arrest procedures into e-learning and so reduce time spent in the classroom. Working alongside expert practitioners, we developed a wide range of video-led branching stop and search scenarios to bring the training alive.

Each scenario has multiple routes and several potential outcomes to deliver a consistent understanding of stop and search powers.

## RAF 'Air Power Study Pack 2'

All officers, from jet pilots to caterers, must be fully conversant with how the RAF contributes to the UK's defence.



This four hour e-learning package demonstrates how to apply the fundamentals of air power by placing learners at the heart of a simulated conflict some time in the near future.

'Sit Rep' tutorials, and newsflashes from embedded reporters in the field keep learners up to date with how the wider conflict is developing. Comprehension is then tested by questions from fellow servicemen in simulated briefings.

The drama of the war zone is bought to life via a rich and varied treatment using video and audio briefings, engaging graphical imagery, animations, real footage and simulated television broadcasts.
